

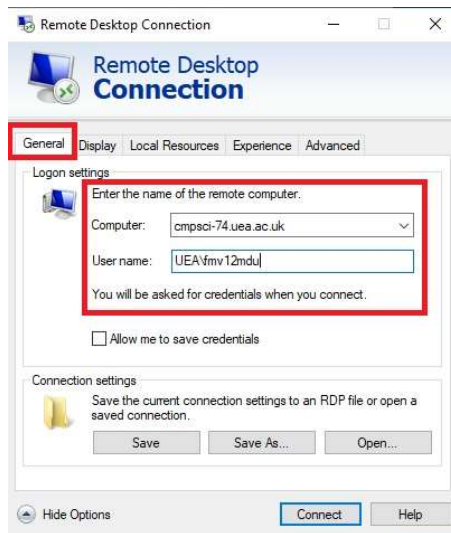
Connecting Remotely to a CMP Lab PC

1. You will need to launch the **Remote Desktop Connection** application from your PC or Laptop. Click on the **show options** setting to change the configuration.



2. Choose a lab computer number from the list on the Wiki to connect to and add **uea.ac.uk** to the end, fill in the configuration details like the example below:-

Computer:	cmpsci-72.uea.ac.uk
User name:	UEA\fmv12mdul



3. Then click on the **advanced tab** and click the settings box under **“Connect from anywhere”**



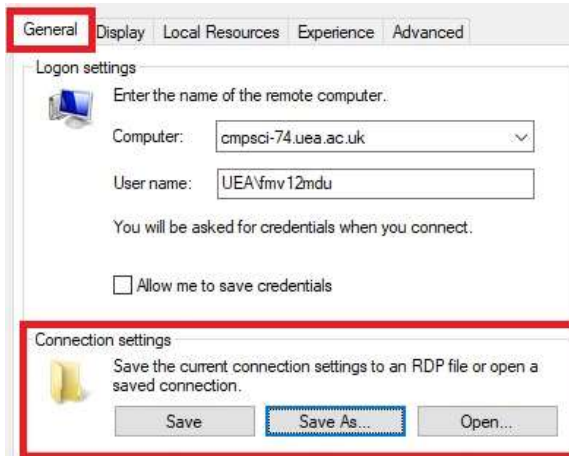
4. Choose the option **"use these RD Gateway server settings"** and input the following RD Gateway server settings:-

RDG server name: cmprdg3.uea.ac.uk



You can also tick the **"use my RD Gateway credential for the remote computer"** so you don't have to input your UEA credentials twice.

5. Once you have entered all the details click ok and go back to the general tab from the top toolbar. Then click on the **save as** option to save a copy of the remote desktop configuration.



6. Once saved run the shortcut or click connect from the Remote Desktop Connection Window



7. You will then be confronted with a warning message. Click connect, you can tick the box “don’t ask me again “if you wish.



8. You will then be prompted to enter your **UEA username** either like this **UEA\fmv12mdu** or **fmv12mdu@uea.ac.uk** and then your **UEA password**.



You may well be prompted to do the same once you authenticate on your UEA PC **(unless you have ticked the checkbox in the RD Gateway Settings)**

9. Remote Desktop should now connect and launch the **CMP Lab PC Desktop**. You can now work on this as if you were sitting at a Lab computer.
